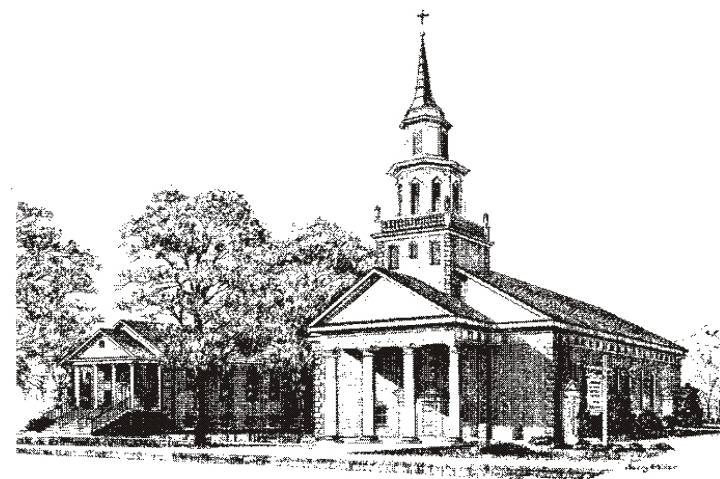

### Becoming a Follower of Christ
